The Steel Guitar in Early

Steel guitar was heard in American country music as early as the 1920s. Jimmie Rodgers featured acoustic steel guitar in his song "Tuck Away My Lonesome Blues" released Jan 3, 1930. In the early 1930s acoustic lap steel guitars were not loud enough to compete with other instruments, a problem that many inventors were trying to remedy.

In the early years of the steel guitar's history, it was found mainly in jazz, swing, Hawaiian, folk, and country music. The well-known players included Alvino Rey, Noel Boggs, Leon McAuliffe, Speedy West, and Joaquin Murphy. But these instrumentalists, as good as they were, found the instrument limited.

Another misnomer: on the mainland in the early days we said, Hawaiian Guitar. Meanwhile in Hawai'i that name is reserved for slack key guitars. As I said, the original steel guitar was a wooden Spanish guitar with a converter nut slipped in to raise the strings, and played with a steel bar.

In 1945, an incredible little pedal steel guitar was designed and mass produced by the Harlin Brothers of Indianapolis, Indiana.
